## Rules

- 1.** Registration is open to all Wood Middle School students and staff. Completed forms must be submitted by **January 31 at 4:00pm** to the Main Office. **Music must be submitted with this form. Turn in a flash drive or CD.** If needed, auditions will be announced. There will be a total of 15-20 Live Lip Sync Battle chosen (student and staff included) for stage performance.
- 2.** Teams can range in size from 1 to 8 people. Eligible team members include current WMS students, faculty, staff, and administration. All team member names must be included on the registration form. Only individuals listed on the registration form can perform. To be eligible, Wood students must have good school attendance.
- 3.** Individuals can only compete in one act.
- 4.** Teams may use props; these props must be included on the registration form to be approved by The Wood Lip Sync Battle Committee. Props not included on registration form cannot be used in the performance. Fog machines, bubble machines, fire, water, and glitter are prohibited. *Microphones will provided.*
- 5.** Music must be submitted with registration form by **January 31 at 4:00pm** for approval by the Wood Lip Sync Battle Committee. Songs must be the clean version, no explicit versions will be accepted. Failure to submit music may result in the team's registration being cancelled. Teams will be notified by via email for the Team captain regarding auditions.
- 6.** The maximum time limit is two minutes per performance. After two minutes, the music will fade out.
- 7.** The Wood Lip Sync Battle Committee reserves the right to cancel registration if the committee feels the act is inappropriate or offensive. If an offensive act is performed, the Wood Lip Sync Battle Committee reserves the right to terminate the performance and the act will be disqualified.
- 8.** Teams **MUST** attend the after-school stage and dress rehearsals which will be announced. Failure to attend will result in disqualification. Actual event is **March 1st** in the evening. All other rehearsals are the responsibility of the teams. Multiple rehearsals are highly encouraged.

**The competition will be judged in these categories:**

- A. Lip Sync Abilities: How well the performer(s) lip-sync the lyrics of the songs.
- B. Creativity: How original and creative the performance is. Instead of just standing on stage and lip-syncing a song - props, choreography, costumes and/or other ideas should be used and often impresses the judges and generates crowd response. Be creative!
- C. Stage Presence & Choreography: Again, don't just stand there! Engage the audience, dance, smile, make eye contact with the judges...you're a STAR ---have fun!
